



Nomination Guidelines for Waste Awards

The Waste Authority's Waste Awards acknowledge and celebrate the outstanding efforts achieved by local government, industry and the community, in reducing waste whilst progressing the Waste Authority's objectives. In the inaugural year of the awards, the focus will be on taking initiatives to reduce waste to landfill.

Preparing a Nomination

To enable our judges to assess your achievements over the past 12 months to July 23, all applications must answer all the selection criteria for their category.

Your entry must include:

- 1) A completed nomination form plus the relevant category form addressing the selection criteria for each category you wish to enter. If you apply for more than 1 category, you will need a separate nomination and category form
- 2) Photos/visual media to support your written application(s)

All nominations must be received by COB 23 July 2010

Tips for Completing your Nomination

- Complete the selection criteria in the application form. Please provide no more than 1000 words in total
- Include photos for each nomination. All photos need to be clearly labelled. Digital format is preferred – high resolution, .JPG files saved to CD and sent with the application
- Include media clippings and other supporting material where possible. If you prefer, you can scan these and also save to CD.

2010 Awards and Selection Criteria

Each of the 5 normal categories rewards the 3 best entrants who best represent high achievement in their fields. A special *Recognition of Excellence* category may also be announced – if the panel identifies a worthy recipient.

The following categories are open for nomination:

- Waste Reduction & Resource Recovery Initiative
- Community Recycling Initiative
- Local Government Waste Reduction Initiative
- Waste Wise Acknowledged School For Creativity And Innovation
- Waste Champion (Individual or Organisation)
