Created especially for young children, 'Save the Faeries' is an inspirational theatrical production developed by renowned Perth faerie, Cara Walker. Incorporating music and performance, it will be presented in an outdoor amphitheatre in Summer 2009.

The production will bring together an array of Perth's artists, musicians and performers who will weave a message of hope for the environment and a safe home for Faeries to survive.

True to it's theme of waste prevention, the production will use costumes, props and sets made of waste material.
